## Dear Parent/Guardian,

In order to comply with Bear Grass Charter School concerning student drivers and parking on campus, Bear Grass Charter School is requiring parent/guardian signature permission before allowing students to drive on campus.

Below you will find the rules that apply to student autos and parking. Please be sure you and your student have read these rules and understand that failure to comply with the rules will result in termination of driving and parking privileges on campus.

Upon reading these rules, please sign and return the letter to the principal for approval, prior to your student driving on campus.

- 1. Students will drive on the right side of the roadway when entering or leaving campus. Passing of slower vehicles is not permitted.
- 2. Students must adhere to the 5 mph speed limit.
- 3. Students must wear seatbelts coming onto campus, leaving campus and while the vehicle is being operated on campus.
- 4. No student may park in more than one parking space.
- 5. Students may only park in the back parking lot.
- 6. Students must park in their assigned space.
- 7. Do not sit in cars or loiter in the parking lot or vehicles after arriving on Campus/nor in the evening unless you have a scheduled event after school.
- 8. No student may go to the parking lot during school hours without permission from the school office.
- 9. The use of a vehicle to skip school, drive in a dangerous manner, or violate other school rules can result in the loss of parking privileges.
- 10. All automobiles should be locked to prevent theft.
- 11. A parking tag must be assigned prior to parking on campus.
- 12. Parking tags must be displayed from the rearview mirror when vehicles are parked on campus.
- 13. Music must be turned down while on campus.
- 14. Students are responsible for all passengers in their vehicle.

You will need the following information for verification, in order to receive your parking pass

- Copy of your *License*
- Copy of *Registration* for the vehicle that will be parked on campus



## The rules of North Carolina Law states as follows

## Level Two Limited Provisional License:

- Drivers must be at least 16 years old.
- All passengers must be restrained by seat belt or child safety seat.
- You may drive without supervision from 5 a.m. until 9 p.m. and at any time when driving directly to or from school, work or any volunteer fire, rescue or EMS (emergency medical service), if you are a member.
- When the license holder is driving the vehicle and is not accompanied by the supervising driver, there may be no more than one passenger under 21 years of age in the vehicle. This limit does not apply to passengers who are members of the license holder's immediate family or whose primary residence is the same household as the license holder. However, if a family member or member of the same household as the license holder who is younger than 21 years of age is a passenger in the vehicle, no other passengers under 21 years of age who are not members of the license holder's immediate family or members of the license holder's household, may be in the vehicle.
- You are not permitted to use a mobile telephone or other additional technology associated with a mobile telephone while operating a motor vehicle on a public street or highway or public vehicular area. {Exception} You can use it to call the following regarding an emergency situation: an emergency response operator; a hospital, physician's office or a health clinic; a public or privately owned ambulance company or service; a fire department; a law enforcement agency; your parent, legal guardian or spouse.
