Meeting Minutes

February 20, 2023

Opening:

The Bear Grass Charter School Board met on February 20, 2023, at the BGCS media center. Delmas Cumbee, Board Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Mrs. Lawrence and the FFA Junior Officers were present for a FFA Presentation. This week is FFA week. The officers gave an overview of the FFA. One-third of the BGCS student population is a FFA member. They spoke about competitions, opportunities within FFA and events that are planned for this week for FFA week.

A brief continued discussion took place among the board regarding a SRO for campus.

Student Enrollment:

Student headcount for the 2022-2023 academic year is currently 423. This has decreased slightly due to early graduates and a withdrawal.

106 new applications have been received for the 2023-2024 academic year.

Calendar:

Principal Bonds reviewed the 2023-2024 Academic Year calendar with the board.

Epicenter Update:

Chairman D. Cumbee has signed off on the Background Check policy. This basically states that BGCS has not changed the way background checks are processed since 2019. Principal Bonds has submitted to Epicenter.

Principal Bonds completed the Annual Report on February 9th. This report details that BGCS offers bus transportation and dual enrollment.

The certificate of liability was returned on February 7th due to the lack of a description from the insurance agency that states NCSBOE is listed as additional insured with regards to general liability and errors in admission statement. This has been resubmitted.

Board/School Policy:

The policy that was on BGCS website was not ours to use. It was a more of a guide to go by. Principal Bonds reviewed a handout provided by David Hofstetter with the board. A brief discussion took place regarding which avenue to go.

The new bus has had cameras installed and is on the road. He reviewed a practice gym quote with the board. He provided the board with a handout of the desired 2023 Summer Projects. This listing contained storage building, lawn mower, new ceilings, floors and windows for various rooms. After discussing his projects, a **motion** was made to move forward with the summer upgrades.

Space Center on March 7^{th} and the Math Team will attend STEM Days at Kings Dominion on April 21^{st} .

Finance:

Review and discussion of the 2022-2023 BGCS budget took place.

Human Resources:

Principal Bonds has a replacement for the finance position. They will start on March 6th.
